Dr. Feng is an Assistant Professor at the Institute of Health Data Analytics and Statistics, National Taiwan University. A statistical geneticist and genetic epidemiologist by training, her research focuses on the genetics of complex traits, with a particular interest in neuropsychiatric disorders. Her work spans the study of how genetic variation across the allele frequency spectrum contributes to disease susceptibility, the improvement of genetic risk prediction through cross-trait and cross-population approaches, and the integration of multi-omics data to understand treatment response and disease progression. Her overarching goal is to translate genomics research into meaningful advances in healthcare and public health.
